## *Order of Proceedings.*

---

1. The Town Clerk will read the Notice convening the meeting.
2. The Mayor (Alderman A. Marshall, J.P.) will then call upon Councillor A. Cooper (Chairman of the Sanatorium Committee) who will propose the following Resolution:—

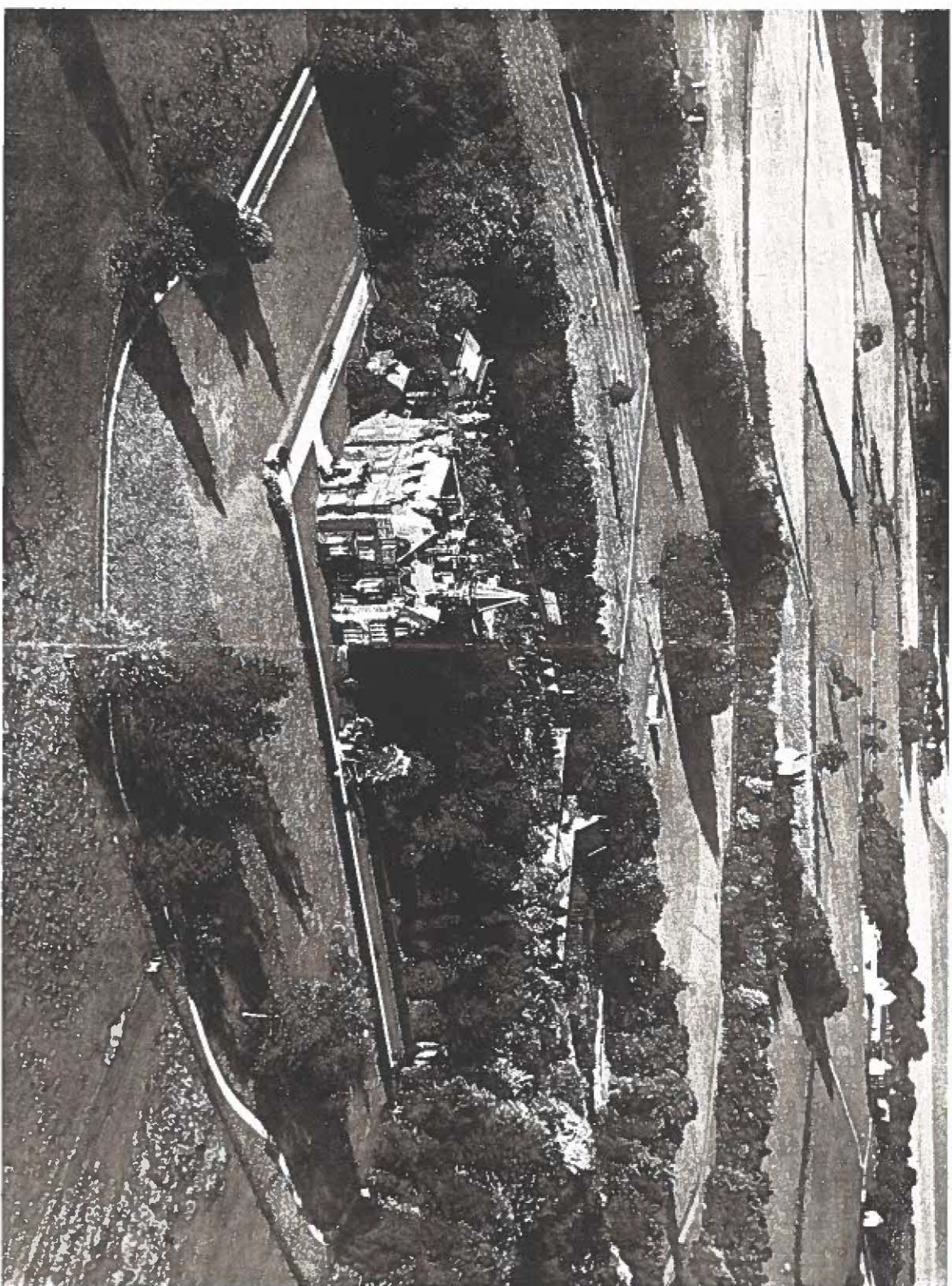
"That this Council in pursuance of the Honorary Freedom of Boroughs Act, 1885, DO HEREBY CONFER upon ALDERMAN AND LIEUT. COL. T. GIBSON POOLE, V.D., J.P., THE HONORARY FREEDOM OF THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH, the most honourable distinction which it is their privilege to bestow, in recognition of the eminent services which have been ungrudgingly rendered by him during his lengthy public career in many capacities and also in further recognition of his munificence in purchasing and presenting to the Town of Middlesbrough the magnificent residence and estate adjoining, known as Grey Towers, Nunthorpe, for the purpose of a Tuberculosis Sanatorium to be known as 'The Poole Sanatorium,' and as a mark of the high esteem in which he is held by his fellow citizens, AND WE DO HEREBY ADMIT ALDERMAN AND LIEUT. COL. T. GIBSON POOLE, V.D., J.P., as an HONORARY FREEMAN of the COUNTY BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH."

3. Alderman W. J. Bruce, O.B.E., J.P., will second the Resolution, after which it will be spoken to by several Members of the Council.
4. The Mayor (Alderman A. Marshall, J.P.) will then announce that, although the conferment of the Honorary Freedom of the Borough is a matter entirely within the jurisdiction of the Town Council, members of the general public may be permitted to speak to the Resolution before it is put to the meeting.
5. The Mayor will then put the Resolution to the meeting, and after the same has been declared carried, will present the Casket containing the Roll of Freedom.
6. Alderman T. Gibson Poole, V.D., J.P., will then sign the Register of Honorary Freemen and afterwards respond to the Presentation.
7. The Members of the Council and others present will then be invited to adjourn to the Town Hall for Light Refreshments.
