Set up a Direct Debit

This guide shows you how to set up a regular Direct Debit to pay your Council Tax.

Click on 'View Direct Debit options', then select whether you want to set up a new Direct Debit or to amend an existing Direct Debit (to change your payment date or bank details).

Setting up a direct debit is a quick and easy way to pay your council tax. You will need your council tax account number together with your bank account details.
