- 1. The Members of the Council and the Guests will be seated in the Town Hall, Middlesbrough prior to 7.00pm.
- 2. The Chair of Middlesbrough Council (Councillor Peter Porley) preceded by the Mace will take his seat.
- The Chair will call upon the Chief Executive to read the Resolution.
- The Chair will call upon Councillor Paul Thompson to propose and Councillor Tom Mawston to second a Resolution to admit Councillor Mrs Hazel Pearson OBE to the Honorary Freedom of the Borough
- 5. After the Resolution has been proposed and seconded the Chair will call upon the Mayor and other Members of the Council to speak to the Resolution.

6. The Chair will put the Resolution to the Meeting, and after the same has been declared carried, the Chief Executive will read the Oath of Freedom as follows:

- 11. The Director of Legal and Democratic Services will report receipt of any communications.
- 12. At the conclusion of the formal proceedings, the Chair will leave the Council Chamber accompanied by all those present holding the Freedom of the Borough.
