# THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (VARIOUS SPEED LIMITS) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough, in exercise of its powers under 82(2), 83(2) and Section 84 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The Order shall come into effect on [16 M August] 2021, and shall be cited as 'The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (Various Speed Limits) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2021'.
- 2. The effect of the Order will be to restrict vehicles to a speed not exceeding:
  - a) 20 mph on the lengths of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule and as shown on the attached plans;
  - b) 30 mph on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule and as shown on the attached plans;
  - c) 40 mph on the lengths of road specified in Part 3 of the Schedule and as shown on the attached plans; and
  - d) 50 mph on the lengths of road specified in Part 4 of the Schedule and as shown on the attached plans;

and to amend or revoke (as appropriate) the provisions of the Orders listed in Part 5 of the Schedule .

3. Exemptions to the restrictions set out in Section 2 above will be permitted for vehicles used in connection with the emergency services whilst on active duty.





A172 Longlands Spur Road (Northbound Carriageway)	From its junction with A1085 Longlands Road to the nosing at its entry onto the westbound carriageway of the A66, a distance of approximately 850 metres.
A172 Longlands Spur Road (Southbound Carriageway)	From the nosing at its exit from the eastbound carriageway of the A66 to its junction with A1085 Longlands Road, a distance of approximately 883 metres.



  - 'B1365 Stokesley Road, from its junction with B1540 Stainton Way for a distance of 1,560 metres in a south easterly direction.'
- 3. Part 4 of the Council of The Borough of Middlesbrough (Various Speed Limits) Traffic Regulation Order 2015 to be amended to read as follows:
  - 'B1365 Stokesley Road, from a point 1,560 metres to the south east of its junction with B1540 Stainton Way to the Middlesbrough/North Yorkshire boundary, a distance of approximately 950 metres.'
- 4. Part I (Article 1) of The County Council of Cleveland (Dockside Road) (Speed Limit) Order 1987 to be amended to read as follows:
  - 'That length of Dockside Road from a point 95 metres to the east of the centre line of its junction with Marsh Road to a point 50 metres to the west of its junction with Works Road, a distance of approximately 500 metres'.
- Schedule 3 of The County Borough of Middlesbrough (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order 1964 to be revoked.
- 6. Schedule 4 of The County Borough of Teesside (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Order 1972 to be revoked.
- 7. The County Council of Cleveland (A66-A19 to North Ormesby Roundabout, Middlesbrough) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990 to be revoked in its entirety.
- 8. The County Council of Cleveland (A172 Middlesbrough Bypass) (50 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 1992 to be revoked in its entirety.








## A172 DIXONS BANK & A172 STOKESLEY ROAD: PROPOSED SPEED LIMITS


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



























### OLD STOKESLEY ROAD, NUNTHORPE: EXISTING AND PROPOSED SPEED LIMITS


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**PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT**
