a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

The Bistro aims to comply with all four licensing objectives and listed below and will be promoted on a daily basis.

Any complaints received will be taken on board and actions implemented to limit any problems that may occur.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

There are security cameras located outside and inside the property. There are further security cameras on the premises next door.

No alcohol will be served to anyone who appears drunk and police will be notified of any incident that may occur. A record log will be kept of any disturbances in and around the area of the property.

c) Public safety

There are smoke detectors and heat alarms within the property if any risk of fire.

There are help alarms in the toilet along with disabled access should any incidents occur whilst occupied.

There are security cameras in and around the property.

All food and safety precautions will be taken when preparing and serving food.

Appropriate health and safety training (such as first aid and fire training) will be provided to staff.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Noise will be contained within the property and any music will only through one Bluetooth speaker. There will be no dancing, daytime or otherwise. No gambling or events held beyond 11pm.

All customers will be asked to respect the neighbours when in and around the premises. All drink will be consumed on the property.

Any vandalism, crime or anti-social behaviour will be recorded and passed on the appropriate authority.

e) The protection of children from harm

Children will be allowed until 20:00 if accompanied by an adult and having a meal.

As the premises is located near a school, the license I am applying for will not serve alcohol until after 16:00 hours during the week.

A challenge 25 order will be in place for any sales of alcohol. Training will be provided for all staff serving alcohol.

There will be no cheap alcohol deals, such as, but not limited to; all you can drink brunches/shots for £1, buy one get one free, or other such deals.

There will be no gambling on site, through machines, events or otherwise.

There will strictly be no adult activities described in Box K above.
