

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
(LINTHORPE ROAD – SECTION OF PEDESTRIANISED AREA)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2018**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough under the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 hereby give Notice because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the length(s) of footpath specified herein.

The effect of this Notice will be to prevent pedestrians from proceeding over those lengths of footpath as specified in the Schedule hereto.

An alternative route is available via Wilson Street, Albert Road, and Corporation Road.

This Notice will not apply to residents and businesses adjacent to the highway and (where necessary) vehicles used in connection with

- (i) the emergency services
- (ii) construction vehicles

This Notice will come into operation on Sunday 24th March 2019 and will continue in force for a period of 2 days up to and including Monday 25th March 2019.

SCHEDULE

The footpath closure commences outside Marks and Spencer shop and then proceeds in a generally southerly direction for approx. 30 metres to the entrance to the Hill Street Centre and includes the covered walkway (Samuel's Arcade) leading from Linthorpe Road to Dundas Arcade.
