TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

**EXTENSION OF FOOTPATH CLOSURE**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (“the Council”) under the provisions of Section 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 applied to the Secretary of State on 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2018 for an extension to the closure of the footpath as referred to in the above named Order because works are continuing to be executed on or near the following length(s) of footpath. The Council received confirmation on 13th August 2018 from the Secretary of State that the extension had been granted.

The effect of the extension will be to restrict all access to the footpath specified in the Schedule to this Notice for a further period of Twelve months ending on 18<sup>th</sup> August 2019 or until the works which is being carried out is completed whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within the period of extension the Order may be extended for a longer period with the approval of the Secretary of State

An alternative route is available via the Bridleway past Grey Towers Farm House to the Roundabout on the A172 then along Dixons bank (A172). The total distance is approximately 704 metres and is shown as a dashed black line on the order plan.

The above Order was originally made on 16<sup>th</sup> February 2018 and provided for the closure of the length of footpath specified in the Schedule hereto to be operative from 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018 for a period of six months or until the works to the length of footpath were completed whichever was the earlier.

**SCHEDULE**

The length of footpath (Middlesbrough No.48) affected commences from its junction with Bridleway No. 49 Middlesbrough at grid reference NZ 53621 13753 then proceeds in a north westerly direction for approximately 408 metres on the east side of the field boundary to its junction with Middlesbrough No. 59 and Dixon’s Bank at grid reference NZ 53361 14068. A total distance of approximately 408 metres and is shown as a solid black line on the order plan.
