

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2017
AMENDMENT ORDER No. 3 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough proposes to make an Order under Sections 32 and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to amend the (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2017 ("the Original Order") by amending the Articles as listed in the Schedule hereto.

Full details and descriptions are contained in the draft Order which, together with an associated plan and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Offices of the Director of Legal & Democratic Services, Town Hall Middlesbrough and at www.middlesbrough.gov.uk. If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should state your grounds in writing to the undersigned by 21 days from the date of this Notice.

SCHEDULE

1. Use of Land and parking place – The following article is added;

"(5) The car parks specified in the schedule hereto may be temporarily subject to a change of use, other than that of a public car park to allow parking for events."

2. Existing Article 4(1) – Amount and payment of charge

"(1) Insofar as a Motor Vehicle is left in a Parking Place specified in Parts I, II, III, IV(A) or V of Schedule 1 the Driver thereof shall pay such charge or charges as are specified in the following provisions of this Order and Schedule 1."

Is amended as follows:

"(1) Insofar as a Motor Vehicle or trailer is left in a Parking Place specified in Parts I, II, III, IV(A) or V of Schedule 1 the Driver thereof shall pay such charge or charges as are specified in the following provisions of this Order and Schedule 1."

3. Existing Article 4(2) – Amount and payment of charge

"4 (2) The charge, referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article shall be payable;"

is amended as follows:

"4 (2) The charge, referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article shall be payable on the leaving of a vehicle or trailer in a parking place;"
