

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF MIDDLESBROUGH COUNCIL'S
STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT**

**PLANNING AND COMPULSORY PURCHASE ACT 2004
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LOCAL DEVELOPMENT)
(ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012**

Middlesbrough Council formally adopted its reviewed Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) on 30 March 2016, in accordance with the above Regulations. The SCI sets out the Council's policy for involving the community in the preparation of local development plan documents and in the consideration of planning applications. Copies of the newly adopted SCI are available for inspection at the Civic Centre, and the town's public libraries. The SCI can also be downloaded from the Council's website at: www.middlesbrough.gov.uk by accessing the Planning Services web-page, and clicking on Planning Policy.

Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision of the Council to adopt its SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SCI was adopted.
